We align our efforts and partnerships - from business and nonprofit agencies to government institutions and schools - around data-focused goals.

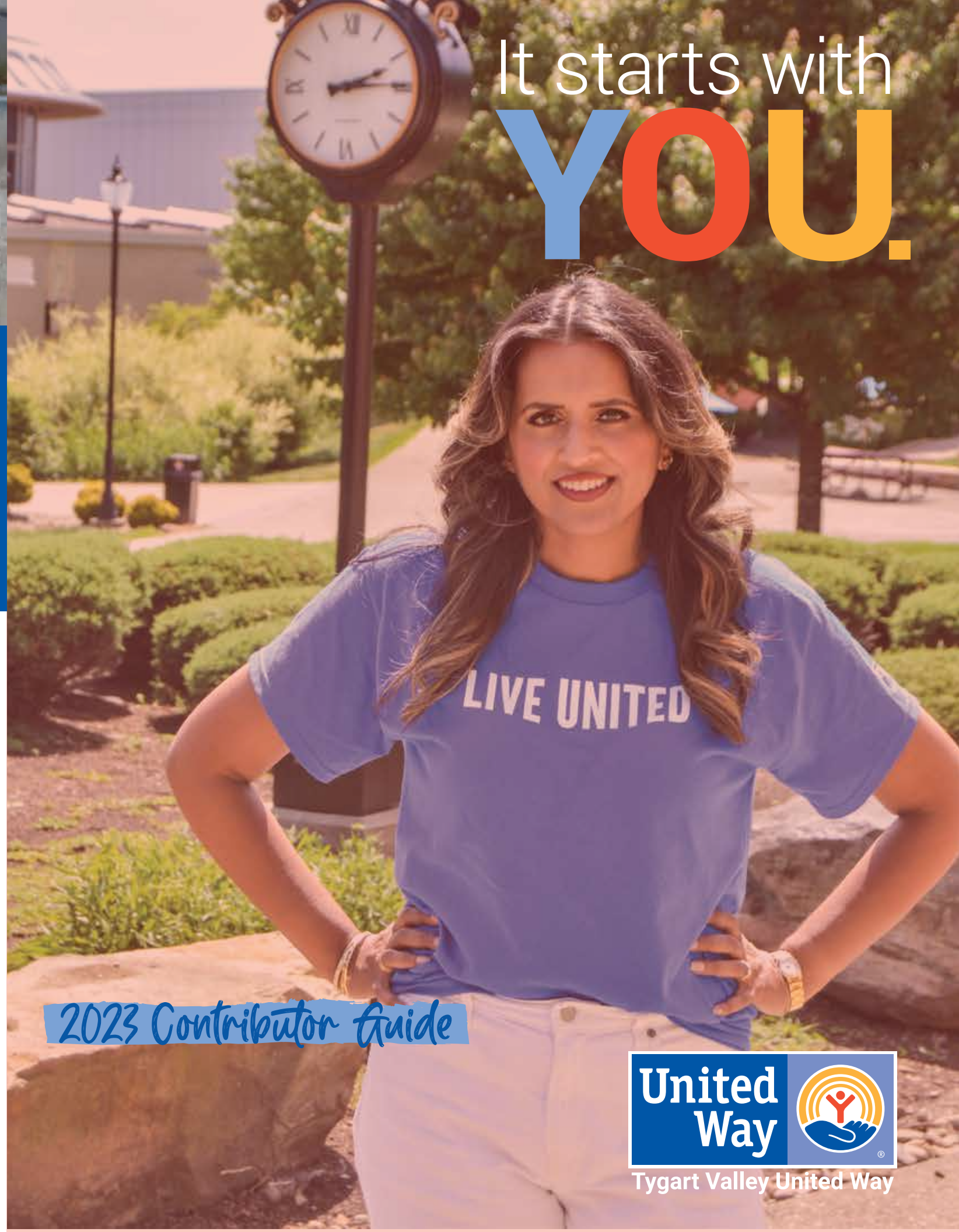

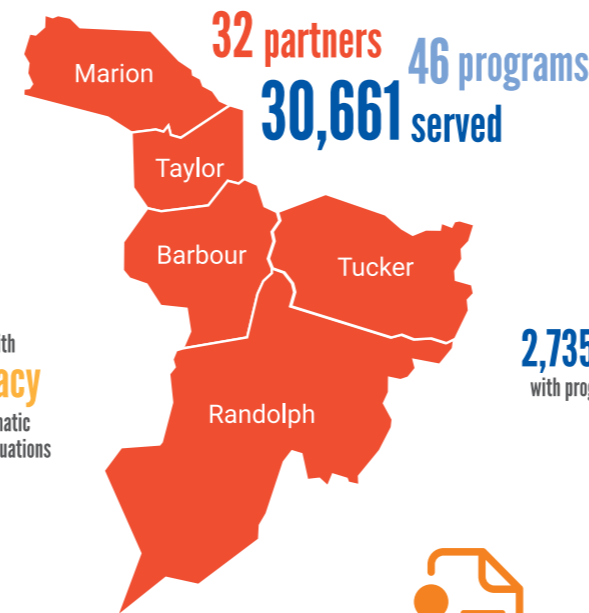

WV 211 is our free and confidential hotline that connects area residents to critical resources when they need help the most. Our statewide database has over 12,000 available resources. It is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Get Connected. Get Help!

Last year, our operators answered over 31,442 requests for help.



VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) is our free tax preparation program that helps individuals file their state and federal taxes for free.

This year, our site prepared over 442 tax returns and helped save families over \$110,500 in tax preparation fees.



Flipside is our afterschool program for middle school students at 4 locations in Marion and Taylor counties. The program is free to all participants and families.

Every day, students will receive a hot meal, homework help, opportunities for physical activity, as well as access to other artistic and scientific activities.



AmeriCorps

The Flipside AmeriCorps program hosts 17 national service members to support the social, academic, and emotional wellness of students at all 4 of the afterschool sites.

Together, the members will provide over 16,600 hours of service during their placement to equip participants with the tools for success throughout life.



United for Kids is our community-wide collection to help young people in all five counties have what they need to face their day with dignity. The drive provides items to stock the pantries at each individual school.

This year, we were able to provide supplies to all 50 schools across the five-county region.



Warm Coats Warm Hearts is our community-wide winter outerwear drive that works with local nonprofit partners to distribute items to those in need.

Last year's drive brought in more than 2,500 items that were put to use immediately, ensuring our neighbors in need were prepared for winter.
