INVOLVEMENT Over 125 local businesses partner with United Way to conduct their annual

fundraising campaign. Last year, over 650 volunteers assisted the organization.

**EFFICIENCY** The administrative rate of 11.1% is significantly lower than the average of 35%

recommended by the Charities Review Council.

RESULTS United Way and its funded partners are working to address the needs in our three impact

areas of Health, Education, and Financial Stability.

• Over 30,339 meals served to families and individuals in need

• Families saved over \$110,500 in tax prep fees using VITA tax prep

• 5,998 individuals received emergency financial assistance

Funding supports 46 programs at 32 health and human service agencies across all

five counties.

United Way internally operates several community impact programs, including West

Virginia 211, VITA Tax Preperation, the United for Kids collection, the Warm Coats

Warm Hearts collection, and the Flipside Afterschool program.

**RESOURCES** In addition to the annual fundraising camapign, United Way also generated over

\$220,000 in grants and sponsorships. Non-financial contributions in the form of

in-kind gifts are valued at over \$75,000.
