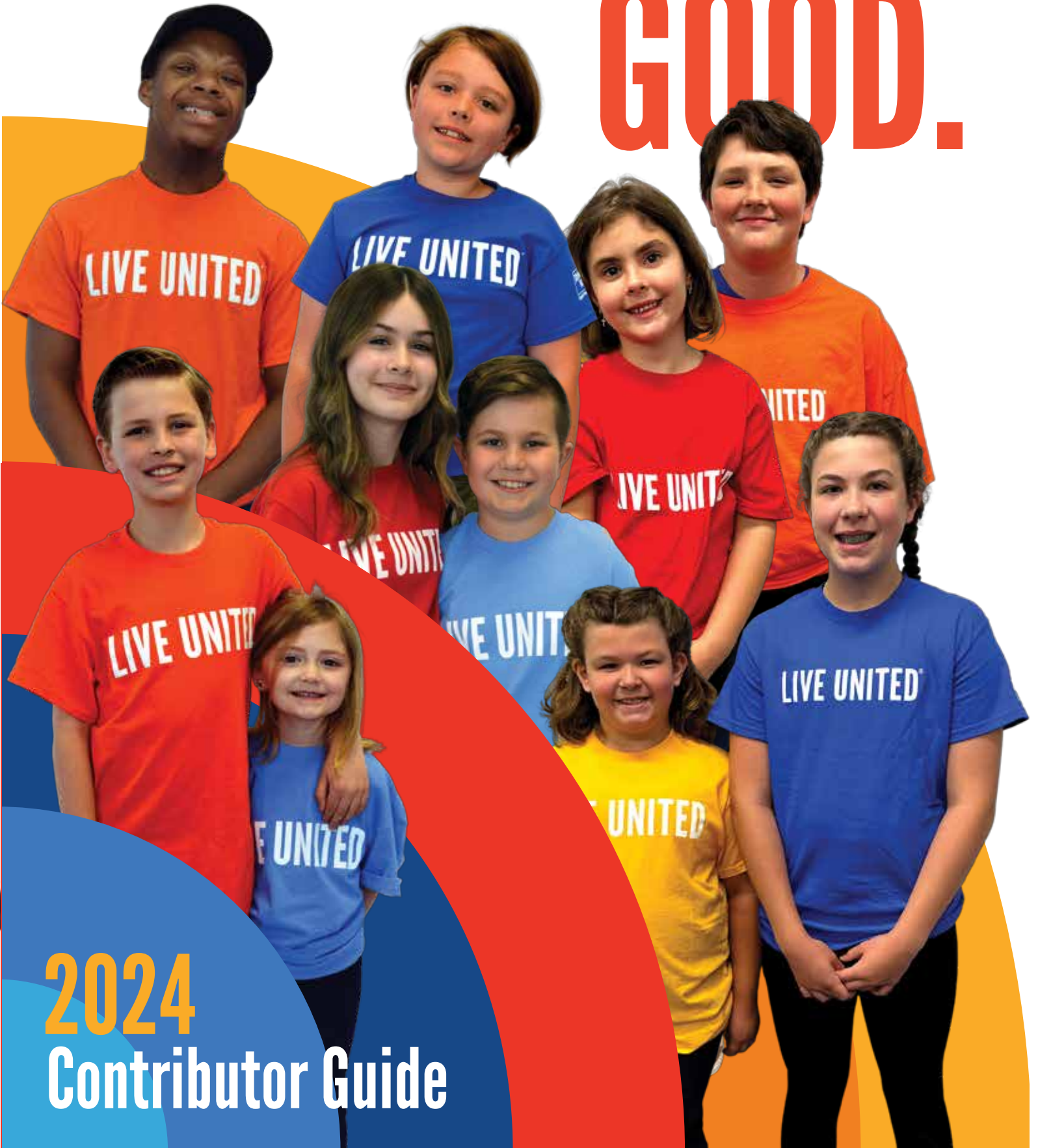

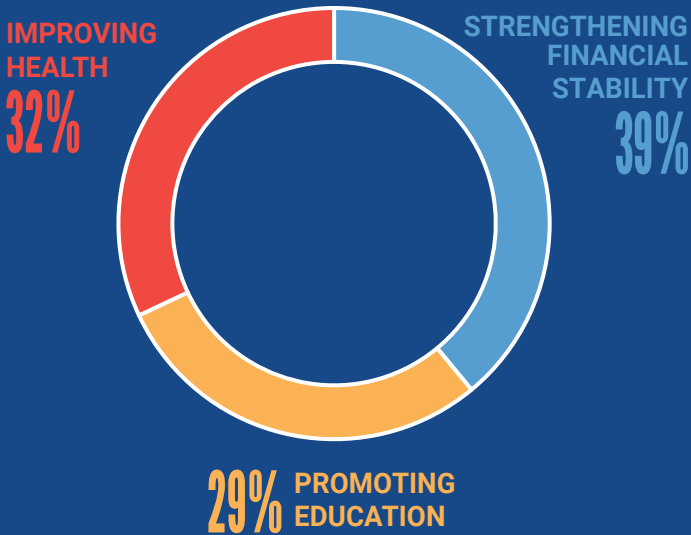

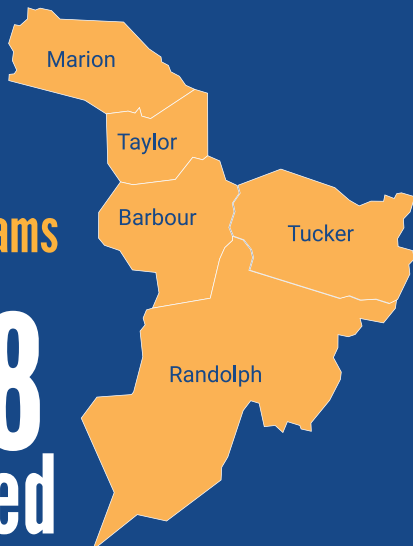

**WV 211** is our free and confidential hotline that connects area residents to critical resources when they need help the most. Our statewide database has over **12,200** available resources. It is available **24** hours a day, **365** days a year. Get Connected. Get Help!

Last year, our operators made **111,670+** connections for individuals in need.



**VITA** (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) is our free tax preparation program that helps individuals file their state and federal taxes for free.

This year, our site prepared **608** tax returns and helped save families more than **\$152,000** in tax preparation fees.



**Flipside** is our afterschool program for middle school students at **4** locations in Marion and Taylor counties. The program is free to all participants and families.

Every day, students will receive a hot meal, homework help, opportunities for physical activity, as well as access to other artistic and scientific activities.



**AmeriCorps**

The **Flipside AmeriCorps** program hosts **17** national service members to support the social, academic, and emotional wellness of students at all **4** of the afterschool sites.

Together, the members will provide **16,600** hours of service during their placement to equip participants with the tools for success throughout life.



**United for Kids** is our community-wide collection to help young people in all five counties have what they need to face their day with dignity. The drive provides items to stock the pantries at each individual school.

This year, we were able to provide supplies to **all 50 schools** across the five-county region.



**Warm Coats Warm Hearts** is our community winter outerwear drive that works with local nonprofit partners to distribute items to those in need.

Last year's drive brought in more than **2,600** items that were put to use immediately, ensuring our neighbors in need were prepared for winter.
