United Way mobilizes our community to action so all can thrive.

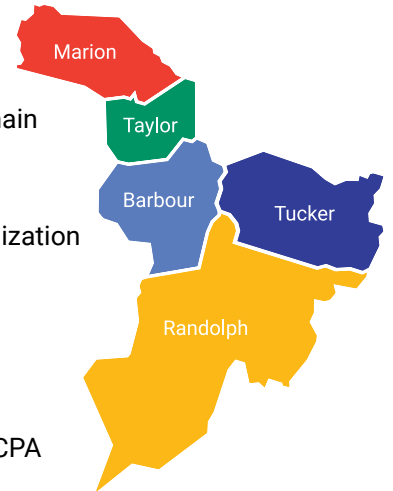
COVERAGE

INVOLVEMENT

Over 75 local businesses partner with United Way to conduct their annual fundraising campaign. Last year, over 400 volunteers assisted the organization.

EFFICIENCY

The administrative rate of 12.2% is significantly lower than the average of 35% recommended by the Charities Review Council.

RESULTS

United Way and its funded partners are working to address the needs in our four impact areas of healthy communities, youth opportunity, financial security, and community resiliency .

- Over 74,440 meals served to families and individuals in need
- Families saved over \$338,100 in tax prep fees using VITA tax prep
- 9,864 individuals received emergency financial assistance

IMPACT

Funding supports 37 programs across 25 different health and human service agencies across all five counties.

United Way internally operates 9 of those programs, including West Virginia 211, VITA Tax Preparation, Born Learning Trails, Opioid Street Outreach, AmeriCorps, Packing for Impact, Pantry Delivery, United We Prepare, and ALICE.

RESOURCES

In addition to the annual fundraising campaign, United Way also generated over \$407,000 in grants and sponsorships. Non-financial contributions in the form of in-kind gifts are valued at over \$75,000.
