

This year, our 5 sites prepared 1,286 tax returns and helped save families across 13 counties more than \$450,100 in tax preparation fees.




United for Kids is our community-wide collection to help young people in all five counties have what they need to face their day with dignity. The drive provides items to stock the hygiene pantries at each individual school.
