Partner agencies across our region have ongoing needs for essential supplies, and Packing for Impact makes it easy for your workplace to meet those needs while creating a meaningful volunteer experience for your employees.

United Way brings volunteerism directly to your workplace. We identify a local nonprofit with a specific need, coordinate all of the supplies, and facilitate a hands on service project at your office. Your team simply shows up, works together, and creates tangible support for neighbors throughout our region.

Each Packing for Impact event begins with a brief interactive presentation that explains why these items matter, the challenges facing our community, and how United Way and our partners are creating lasting change. Every participant leaves knowing exactly how their efforts will make a difference.

Events can be scheduled around your workplace calendar and are ideal for groups of 5 to 50 volunteers. Projects typically last 30 minutes to two hours, depending on your group size and the number of kits being assembled.

A clean home supports healthier families and stronger communities. These kits include everyday cleaning supplies that many households struggle to afford. They help families maintain safe, healthy living environments while stretching limited budgets.



School Supply Kit

Give students the tools they need to start the school year ready to learn. Each kit includes classroom essentials that help remove barriers to academic success and support local teachers and families. Every backpack or supply kit helps set a child up for success.



Winter Warmth Kit

Help neighbors stay warm during West Virginia's cold winter months. Kits include seasonal essentials that provide comfort and protection when temperatures drop. A simple collection of items can make winter safer for someone in need.



Senior Comfort Kit

Brighten the day of an older adult with practical items that provide comfort, care, and connection. These kits are distributed through agencies serving seniors throughout our region. A small act of kindness can make a meaningful difference.



Summer Safety Kit
